- Work with internal and external analytics teams to improve underwriting reporting, process efficiency, and integrate other systems into dashboards or similar, both from wider CGM teams and the overall Chubb network

- Take ownership for the team's data science strategy.
- Evaluate new and emerging technologies especially regarding the application of Generative AI.
- Build relationships with wider data teams within Chubb.
